Marin County

Fees: \$45 and can request a fee waiver at the same time as the application

Process: Can go to the office to request an application or call. Then you fill it out and return to the office in a blue envelope that is given at time of the request of the application.

Time: 4-10 months for the whole process to happen. After the process is finish they would receive a conformation letter.
